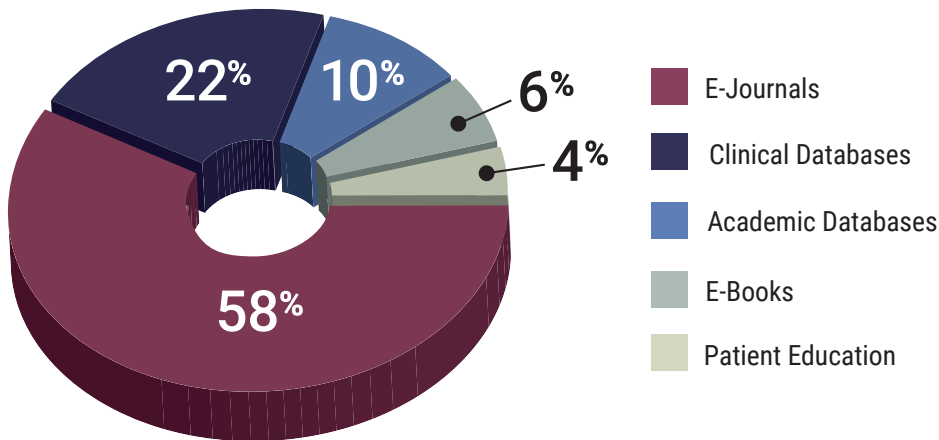


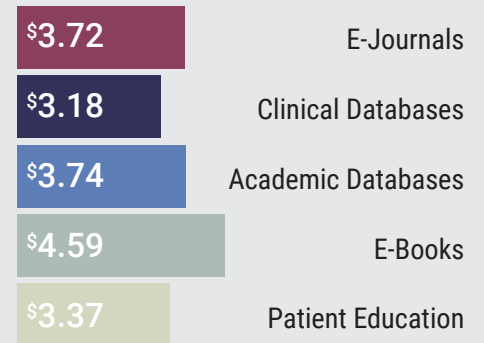
## RESOURCE SPENDING

In fiscal year 2017-18, the Library spent **\$1,680,600** on electronic resources.



## COST PER USE

The Library provides access to more than 45,000 journals, 85 clinical, academic, and research databases, and 300+ electronic reference, text & review books. We consistently review usage to ensure the best return on our investment.

## BEST RETURN ON INVESTMENT

In 2017, we spent **\$34,951** to deliver **11,386** articles from **1,072** journals. Based on an **average of \$1,736 per journal title**, licensing these titles would cost Upstate **\$1,860,992** – **533%** more than buying articles on demand.

## ACADEMIC & CLINICAL SERVICES

In 2017, our Academic and Clinical Services team taught **4,754** people to be more effective consumers of information in **148** instructional sessions.

This represents **75%** more attendees and **134%** more sessions than the previous year.

## ARCHIVES & SPECIAL COLLECTIONS

The vault contains nearly 13,000 rare books and journals dating from the 17th century, and more than 330 pieces of antique medical and laboratory equipment. Finding aids for thirty archival collections, totaling nearly 100 linear feet of materials, are available online to assist researchers.

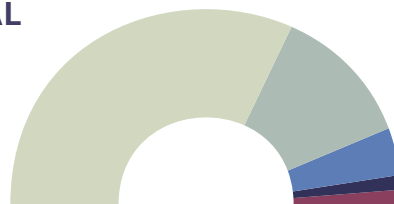
